- 5) Mailing written notice to each person who has requested copies of the Regular Meeting Schedule and who has prepaid any charge fixed for such service.

3. <u>EXECUTIVE SESSION:</u>

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b), permits the exclusion of the public from a meeting in certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that such circumstances exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the North Hanover Township Board of Education, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:17-9 and 18A:17-36; that the district's financial accounts have been reconciled and are in balance."

Through the adoption of this resolution, we, the North Hanover Township Board of Education, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-16.10 (b), certify that as of March 31, 2020 and after review of the Secretary's and Treasurer's monthly financial reports (appropriation section) and upon consultation with the Business Administrator and other appropriate district officials, that to the best of our knowledge no major account or fund has been over expended in violation of N.J.A.C.6A:23A-16.10 (b), and that sufficient funds are available to meet the district's financial obligations for the remainder of the fiscal year.

6. PUBLIC HEARING AND ADOPTION OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR BUDGET

A presentation on the 2020-2021 Budget and a Public Hearing will be conducted.

Motion for the Board approve the following resolutions:

6.1 Adoption of the 2020-2021 School Year Budget And Tax Levy

WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education adopted a tentative budget on March 10, 2020 to be submitted to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 14, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Burlington County Times on May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was presented to the public during a public hearing on May 5, 2020; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the budget be adopted for the 2020-2021 School Year and the Secretary to the Board of Education be authorized to submit the following adopted budget to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools in accordance with the statutory deadline:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the North Hanover Township Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for increased enrollment in the amount of \$71,652. The additional funds are included in the base budget and will be used to pay for the additional increases in new staff salaries; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the North Hanover Township Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for the use of banked cap in the amount of \$139,034. The additional funds are included in the base budget and will be used to pay for the additional increases in new staff salaries by June 30, 2021.

6.2 Travel and Related Expense Reimbursement 2020-2021

WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.2 et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by

the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel as defined in NJAC 6A:23A-1.2, which includes attendance at regularly scheduled in-State county meetings, Department or Association sponsored events or in-State professional development activities for which the registration fee does not exceed \$150.00 per employee or board member, where prior Board approval shall not be required unless the annual threshold for a staff member exceeds \$1,500 in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and

WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education established \$85,000 as the maximum travel amount for the current school year and has expended \$46,612.89 as of this date; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A: 23A-7.3, to a maximum expenditure of \$85,000 for all staff and board members for the 2020-2021 school year.

6.3 4F Tax Levy Certification Form A and B

RESOLVED, that the amount required for school purposes in the school district of North Hanover Township, County of Burlington for the 2020-2021 school year is \$3,361,491 and is required to be levied for local school district purposes.

RESOLUTION OF THE NORTH HANOVER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ACCEPT A BID AND AWARD A CONTRACT WITH J.H. WILLIAMS ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR THE PHASE III GENERAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT AT ENDEAVOUR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education advertised for bids for a Phase III General Construction Project at Endeavour Elementary School Project and two bids were received on April 21, 2020; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the bids, the Board's Construction Manager, PW Moss and Associates, have recommended the awarding of the contract to J.H. Williams Enterprises, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, J.H. Williams Enterprises, Inc. has submitted a base bid in the amount \$325,000 ("the proposal"), a copy of which is on file in the office of the Board Secretary/Business Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the bidder has submitted all required documents in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law and the Board's specifications; and

WHEREAS, the Board Secretary/ Business Administrator has certified that funding for this project is available,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the North Hanover Township Board of Education, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the total bid in the amount of \$325,000.00 is accepted and that the contract for the Phase III General Construction Project at Endeavour Elementary School is awarded to J.H. Williams Enterprises, Inc.

9.4 <u>Impact Aid Reserve Transfer</u>

To approve the transfer from Impact Aid Reserve account in the amount of \$600,000 to the general fund budget for costs associated with the renovation project at CB Lamb Elementary School.

9.5 <u>COMPUTER SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE-ACCOUNTING</u>

WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education has need for Computer Software Maintenance services to assist the district in daily usage of budget, payroll, and personnel software for the 2020-2021 School Year, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the required services are specialized in nature, require expertise in the field of computers and software, and is not reasonably possible to describe the required services with written bid specifications; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the North Hanover Township Board of Education shall award a contract in the amount of \$18,375 for these services during the 2020-2021 school year as an extraordinary unspecifiable service to Asbury Park Information Technology Center, Asbury Park, NJ.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the details of the computer software maintenance services and the costs will be covered by a mutually agreed upon contract filed in the Business Administrator/Board Secretary's Office.

9.6 <u>2020-2021 Food Service Management Contract</u>

To renew the food service management contract with Nutri-Serve Food Management, Inc. at the flat fee of \$43,948.79 for the 2020/2021 school year.
