WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education adopted a tentative budget on March 23, 2021 to be submitted to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on March 31, 2021, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Burlington County Times on April 18, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was presented to the public during a public hearing on April 27, 2021; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the budget be adopted for the 2021-2022 School Year and the Secretary to the Board of Education be authorized to submit the following adopted budget to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools in accordance with the statutory deadline:

5.2 Travel and Related Expense Reimbursement 2021-2022

WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.2 et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel as defined in NJAC 6A:23A-1.2, which includes attendance at regularly scheduled in-State county meetings, Department or Association sponsored events or in-State professional development activities for which the registration fee does not exceed \$150.00 per employee or board member, where prior Board approval shall not be required unless the annual threshold for a staff member exceeds \$1,500 in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and WHEREAS, the North Hanover Township Board of Education established \$85,000 as the maximum travel amount for the current school year and has expended \$46,612.89 as of this date; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A: 23A-7.3, to a maximum expenditure of \$85,000 for all staff and board members for the 2021-2022 school year.
